Explore your legal side or your dramatic side while having fun!
<b>Singing with the “Dominoes”</b> Why wait to just <i>hear</i> the award-winning “Dominoes” in Carnegie Hall, or <i>see</i> them on News 12 NJ, when you can <i>sing</i> with them right here at SDA! Learn and rehearse numbers from their spring repertoire. All who love to sing are welcome!	<b>CSI at SDA: <i>Tragic suicide or horrible murder?</i></b> You will decide as you perform blood, hair, fiber, fingerprint and handwriting analysis tests. Here’s a chance to relate biology and chemistry to all the intrigue, mystery, and excitement of real life crime-scene investigations.
<b>Find your Inner Poet:</b> Anyone can write a poem; now, it’s your turn! Using friendly and non-threatening poetry prompts, participants will produce original poems – and decorate them, too!	<b>Broadway, Here I Come:</b> Tips on voice, expression, memorization and movement will be learned through a series of acting games. Performing short scenes will also be part of this Drama workshop.
<b>“Under the Sea” at SDA:</b> Learn about Marine Animals – how do they survive, what do they eat, in what temperature can they live, what is their life span, do they share common characteristics? Then design an aquarium for the live Marine Animal of your choice.	<b>Chemistry for “Chids”: Slime Making Contest!</b> Learn basic chemistry facts and then put them to work when you create your own slime! Whichever student can create the most colorful slime in 30 minutes will win a prize! You will also get to take your slime home!
<b>Team Challenge:</b> Students will work individually and in small groups to solve challenges/tasks/puzzles imposed on them by the instructor. They include: Group Walk, Juggling, Human Knot and Totem Pole. Have fun while experiencing physical, mental, and social challenges as you attempt to solve each task.
