SDA Appoints New Academic Dean

Veteran English Teacher Assumes New Role



SDA English teacher John Seborowski was promoted to Academic Dean.

After 12 years of teaching English at SDA, John Seborowski has been duly chosen to take on a new role as the Academy's Academic Dean. For the past seven years, "Mr. Seb" has served as the English Department Chairperson and has been the Director of the Summer Program for the past four years.

With the departure of Mr. Tom Corbo, who served as principal for the last two years, Head of School Barbara Griffin looked for someone to take over the responsibility for the academic program. Based on her experience with the faculty, she immediately thought of Mr. Seborowski. She observed, "Who knows the program better than a

respected member of the faculty for over 10 years? I have every confidence that John will bring great energy and enthusiasm to his new role."

While Mr. Seborowski began teaching at SDA in 2000, he has been part of the SDA Family since the first of his four sisters entered as a freshman in 1995. Along with Beth who graduated in 1999, his three other sisters are Lynne '01, Claire '03 and Louise '05.

"My sisters have all told me that they are extremely proud that I have a position of leadership at their alma mater," stated Mr. Seborowski. "In fact, my mother and father often joke and say they are the only parents in SDA history to put four daughters and a son through the Academy."

Mr. Seborowski received his Bachelor of Arts Degree from Flagler University in Florida in 2000 and his Master's Degree in Administration/Supervision in 2007 from Saint Peter's College, now Saint Peter's University. In his 12 years at SDA, Mr. Seborowski has certainly played a strong role in the education and empowerment of hundreds of young women and he appreciates the classroom teaching atmosphere of the Academy.

"When I listen to friends who teach at other schools, they always comment on how hard it is to come in and simply be able to teach the objective of the day," he states. "I have never felt that way in this building because we really do have amazing young women who know why they are here and want to make the most of their time here."






Summer Visit




