Host families receive a monthly stipend of \$1100 to cover any costs that arise with having an extra person in the home. Host families also have access to ongoing support from a local Residential Coordinator.

Families are welcome to host a student for one or two semesters, but there is also the possibility of choosing to host again the following year. The students typically study in the United States with the intention of graduating from an American high school.
