Public Speaking: Learn how to use your voice, facial expressions and hand gestures to take command of your audience.

Becoming Leaders: Go on a journey of transition to become more confident and self-assured.

Physics “Pfun”: Acquire skills through hands-on, inquiry based approaches to information and concepts.

Interactive Activities for Math Development: Enhance your prior knowledge of mathematical concepts through fun games and hands-on learning. Acquire a better understanding of math applications as preparation for standardized testing.

Exploring World Languages: Learn basic conversational phrases in French, Spanish and Italian while receiving a cultural and historical appreciation of other societies and customs.

Study Skills: Focus on critical thinking skills, reading assignments and basic research as well as time management skills, memory tips, word analysis and note taking.

Cardio Fun: Participate in all different types of physical activities, such as Zumba, soccer, hockey, and ultimate Frisbee.
